RESIT EXAM RULES REMINDER:

- Unless the students produce a valid medical certificate to the supervisor, they wont be given a chance to do a RESIT exam.
- If the student is unable to produce a medical certificate but the reasons are really genuine - Parents should email to myself, copying the Supervisors so we can assess the situation and give a resit test. For instance, some emergencies in the family, accidents, death in the family. The resit will be scheduled within the next 2 days of the Missed test with a different version of the question paper.
